- A. Disciplinary summary for the Spring and Fall 2024 seasons.
 - 1. Referee abuse is down
 - 2. Too many player subs
 - a. illegal players now leading in issues raised
 - 3. Provided assignor feedback on good refs
 - 4. Uniform issues Clubs using t-shirts; no logos; no numbers; not same color

- 5. Field issues Clubs not clearly marking fields and need the appropriate goals
 - a. Goal anchoring if not anchored, there will be no game, it is canceled.
 - It is not a referee decision. It is a mandate. Home coach's responsibility
- 6. Racial slurs many reports of this issue.
 - a. Bring to the Referee attention and provide write up to provide tracking.
 - b. Clubs should discuss protocol for this type of behavior
 - c. This is not acceptable and should be stopped
- 7. MSYSA AGM spoke about referee training
 - a. Looking to put a committee together to approach MRC
 - b. Kids need mentors and someone helping at fields
 - c. Zoom meeting for referees to ask questions.
